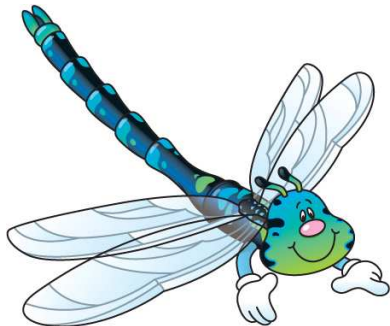

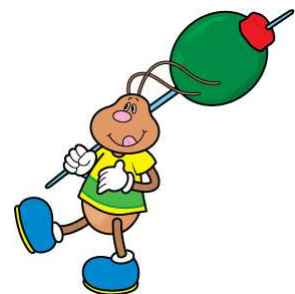

Discussed that new t-shirts will be sold for \$12.00 ea. and last year's t-shirts will be sold for \$8.00ea.

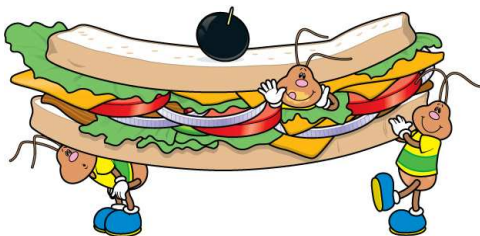
Brenda Williams will place an ad about car show in the newspaper.

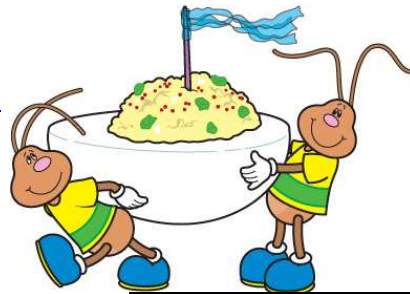
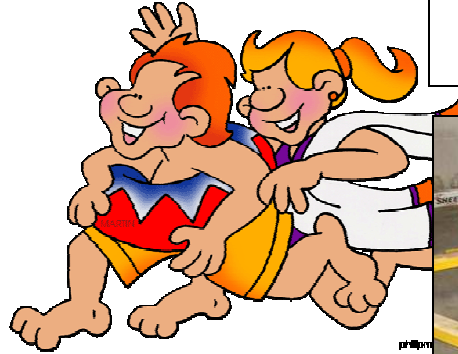
